FISH CULTIVATION IN BORDUUA BEEL BY CHATIA COLLEGE

It is a fact that the Bordua Beel area was devoid of a higher educational institution prior to 1982 and the people of the area established the institution without any Government fund at that time but to keep it operational required a sufficient amount of money. Therefore, after discussion with the *Gaon Panchayat* the decision to take up the practice of fish cultivation in available unutilized water bodies was considered and put into practices to keep the institution running. The result of the practice shows that rectification in the previous practices of submitting application by farmers for contract of running the *beel* and selection of applicant through discussion to the present process of inviting tender has led to increase in revenue earning more than three times.








