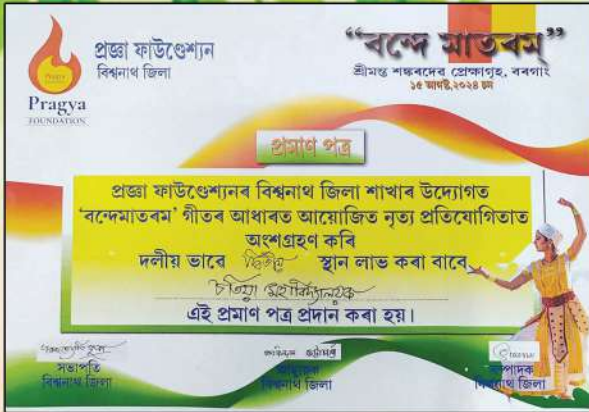

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND GENERAL RULES

1. Photo-copies of marksheets duly attested are to be submitted with the Admission Form. But the original testimonials must be produced at the time of interview for admission.
2. In the case of Break of studies, the 'Gap Certificate' from a magistrate verifying character and stating the reasons of inability for pursuing studies during the gap period must be submitted with the Application Form for admission.
3. Selection of the students for admission is normally done on the basis of the results of the last examination passed. The policy of the reservation of seats is strictly in accordance with the Govt. norms.
4. Fees mentioned in the prospectus are subject to revision from time to time.
5. A Guardian's declaration authorising the college authority to take action against his/her ward if he/she violates the Rules and Regulations of the College must be enclosed in the application form for admission.
6. The student seeking admission from the other states or universities must submit Migration Certificate within 3(three) months from the date of their admission.
7. The students once admitted in the college must strictly adhere to the rules of the college regarding the College-uniform so as to prevent entrance of outsiders into the College campus during college hours.
8. Students indiscipline in terms of ragging, teasing, misbehaving fellow-students or teachers is strictly prohibited.
9. 80% attendance in class and active participation in extra co-curricular activities and academic enterprises like Seminars, Talks, Debate, Symposium etc. is mandatory.
10. Smoking and use of alcohol within the College campus are strictly prohibited.
11. Plying of vehicles within the College campus during the class hours are prohibited so as to maintain peace and discipline in all respects.
12. Prior permission from the Principal must be obtained for holding all kinds of meet-ings or assemblies within the College campus so that the smooth functioning of the classes or office works may not be affected.
13. It is compulsory for all students to sit for all Departmental, Terminal, Test, Annual Examinations of the college. Medical certificates are not entertained for pro-motion.
14. Use of mobile phone inside the College campus is strictly prohibited.
